



## HOW TO JOIN BRITISH JUDO AS A MEMBER

All judoka wishing to train on the mat and complete gradings will be required to become a member of the British Judo Association. This can be done by following the following steps.

- 1) Go to the website <https://www.britishjudo.org.uk/>

- 2) Click on the link for Dojo Login



- 3) Click on New member? Sign up here



- 4) Enter an email address. If children are under 18, please use a parent's email address to set up the account. You can link multiple people to one account.
- 5) You will receive an email from British Judo. Please follow the link in the email to activate your account.
- 6) Enter the details asked for to set up an account. If you are a parent/guardian of a member, you can select this from the drop tab.

- 7) You will then be able to login to the account.



- 8) You will need to enter your details to set up the rest of the account. You can do this by clicking edit profile.



- 9) Enter the details required. At the bottom of the page, you can add in the club name. Please enter Wokingham Judo Club. BJA area is NHC and the Fighting County is Berkshire.

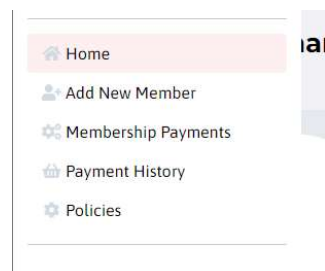

- 10) Click the three lines at the top of the page. This will allow you to add more members if you have signed up as a parent and need to add children.



- 11) If you click on membership payments, this will allow you to choose who you want a membership for. Click on the name required and choose the type of membership. You will need a full membership to complete gradings and options should be given to you based on the Judoka's age.



- 12) You will be directed to a payment page to pay for your membership.
- 13) Once your membership has been confirmed, you will received a licence book and licence card from the British Judo Association in the post. The book stays with you throughout your judo career and is used to record gradings that take place. The licence card is renewed each year with your membership and should be changed in your licence book when a new one is received.
